

The Board of Supervisors of Shelby County, Iowa, met pursuant to law and rules of said board in special session at 8:30 A.M. in the courthouse with the following members present: LaVon A. Christensen, Chairman; Richard Ferry; and Marsha J. Carter, Clerk. Absent: Gayle Petersen, Vice-Chairman.

It was moved by Ferry, seconded by Christensen, to approve the agenda. Motion carried.

This being the day set by law for the board to canvass the returns of the Shelby County School Election held on September 11, 2001, the board did canvass with the following results:

Public Measure A

“Shall the Iowa Western Community College (Merged Area XIII) in the Counties of Adair, Adams, Audubon, Cass, Crawford, Fremont, Harrison, Mills, Monona, Montgomery, Page, Pottawattamie, and Shelby be authorized to improve campus and other enrollment locations and remodel, erect and equip buildings thereon, contract indebtedness therefor, and issue its school bonds in an amount not exceeding \$5,500,000 for that purpose?”

There were 415 votes cast for the proposition of which 217 were YES and 198 were NO.

The Board ordered the Auditor to certify these results to Pottawattamie County, the control county for IWCC.
