The Board of Supervisors of Shelby County, Iowa, met pursuant to law and rules of said board in special session at 9:00 a.m. in the Supervisors Chambers of the Shelby County Courthouse with the following members present: LaVon A. Christensen, Chairman; Gayle Petersen, Vice-Chairman; Richard Ferry; and Marsha J. Carter, Clerk.

It was moved by Petersen, seconded by Christensen, to approve the agenda. AYES: Christensen, Petersen, Ferry NAYES: None

This being the day set by law for the board to canvass the Harlan Community School Instructional Support Levy Election of February 5, 2002, the board did canvass with the following results:

Public Measure A: "Shall the board of directors of the Harlan Community School District in the Counties of Shelby and Harrison, State of Iowa, be authorized for a period of ten (10) years to levy and impose an instructional support tax in an amount (after taking into consideration instructional support state aid) not exceeding ten percent (10%) of the total regular program district cost for the budget year and monies received under Iowa Code Section 257.14, as a budget adjustment in the budget year, and be authorized annually, in combination, as determined by the Board, to levy an instructional support property tax upon all the taxable property within the school district commencing with the levy of property taxes for collection in the fiscal year ending June 30, 2003, and to impose an instructional support income surtax upon the state individual income tax of each individual income taxpayer resident in the School District on December 31 for each calendar year commencing with calendar year 2002, or each year thereafter? The percentages of income surtax and property tax will remain as close as possible at the one-third (1/3) property and two-thirds (2/3) income tax level."

There were One Thousand Eight Hundred Seventy One (1871) ballots cast of which One Thousand two Hundred (1200) were YES and Six Hundred Seventy One (671) were NO.

The Board declared Public Measure A as passed.

There being no further business appearing, the Chairman declared the meeting adjourned at 9:40 a.m.
