It was moved by Hull, seconded by Burmeister, to set the date for the auction for the cash rent of the County Farm land as 9:00 a.m. on November 20, 2012. AYES: Schmitz, Burmeister, Hull NAYES: None

Jennifer Muff, Public Health Administrator, appeared before the Board to request that the FY2014 funding for Public Health be increased to \$100,000. It was moved by Burmeister to increase the funding to Myrtue Medical Center - Public Health from \$57,500 to \$77,500 for FY2014. The motion died for lack of second. Chairman Schmitz stated that this matter would be discussed during the FY2014 budget process.

Lonnie Maguire, Community Services Director, appeared before the Board to discuss the regionalization of the mental health system and individual County funding. The newly formed region will include nine counties with five CPCs. It was suggested by the representatives for the region that the individual County funding be pooled for mental health services. It was moved by Hull, seconded by Burmeister, to approve the recommendation of the mental health region representatives of pooling the County funds for mental health services. AYES: Schmitz, Burmeister, Hull NAYES: None

Maguire also presented her FY2012 Annual Report to the Board.

The Board had received a notice from ISAC that the County Rate Information System (CRIS) 28E Agreement will be terminated as of June 30, 2013. Maguire explained that this system is being phased out.

It was moved by Hull, seconded by Burmeister, to appoint Alison Manz to the Solid Waste Agency Board to fill the unexpired term of Lloyd Robinson, term expiring March 1, 2013. AYES: Schmitz, Burmeister, Hull NAYES: None

Dan Ahart, County Engineer, was available to update the Board on activities of the county road crews and the status of current maintenance and construction projects.

It was moved by Burmeister, seconded by Hull, to approve the Iowa Department of Transportation Agreement between Shelby County and the IDOT for Federal Highway Bridge Program Funding BRS-CO83(53) – 60-83 F32 (Kennedy Road) Bridge Replacement. AYES: Schmitz, Burmeister, Hull NAYES: None

There being no further business appearing, the Chairman declared the meeting adjourned at 10:32 a.m.
