The Board of Supervisors of Shelby County, Iowa, met pursuant to law and rules of said board in regular session at 9:00 a.m. in the Supervisors Chambers of the Shelby County Courthouse with the following members present: Roger Schmitz, Chairman; Steve Kenkel, Vice-Chairman; Charles Parkhurst; and Marsha J. Kenkel reported the Southwest Iowa Mental Health Region has added two Mental Health support staff. These two individuals will make scheduled visits to the jails in the Region to make sure the prisoners with mental health issues are getting the necessary services. The goal is earlier intervention and less time in the jail system.

Dan Ahart, County Engineer, was available to update the Board on activities of the county road crews and the status of current maintenance and construction projects.

Ahart discussed the difficulties of obtaining a supply of rock for the roads, and Shelby County is in competition with other counties from the suppliers. There are no quarries in Shelby County, so it is being delivered by truck or rail from other parts of Iowa. Ahart did comment that rock will become a precious commodity in the years ahead.
