

November 10, 2020

The Board of Supervisors of Shelby County, Iowa, met pursuant to law and rules of said board in special session at 12:00 noon in the Supervisors Chambers of the Shelby County Courthouse with the following members present: Charles Parkhurst, Chairman; Darin Haake, Vice-Chairman; Steve Kenkel; and Mark Maxwell, Clerk.

The Chair asked that any Conflict of Interest be stated concerning any item on the agenda. None were stated.

It was moved by Kenkel, seconded by Haake, to approve the agenda. AYES: Haake, Kenkel and Parkhurst NAYES: None

Discussion was held on the subjects of reporting to other departments if your employees are ill to other departments and the wearing of masks. Conversation was held discussing employees currently ill and those who have been in the past and that other departments want to know when someone is ill in another department so that precaution can be made. It was agreed that it would be communicated with all departments when we do have positive cases within our employees so that other could better defend themselves and that no names would be disclosed.

Alex Londo, Shelby County emergency Management Coordinator offered useful information gleaned by Shelby county EMA as well as Jordan Sanders, head assistant Shelby County EMA. Both commented on a governor’s proclamation that was made public shortly before the Supervisors opened this meeting.

The subject of wearing masks in administrative facilities was discussed in depth with the and past employees being ill, current the current pandemic situation and how it is affecting Courthouse operations. The Supervisors all agreed that doing nothing was not an option. Wording was discussed, and a motion was then made by Kenkel and seconded by Haake to make the wearing of masks mandatory in all situations by visitors and staff in all Shelby County Administrative buildings. Marcus Gross, Shelby County Attorney offered his expertise in crafting a policy that will cover the intentions of the motion. The policy will be drawn up by Gross and signed by Chairman Parkhurst.

This being the day set by law for the Board to canvass the results of the General Election of November 3, 2020, the Board did canvass the returns.

It was moved by Kenkel, seconded by Haake, to designate the Auditor’s Office to compile the results from each polling site for the canvass. AYES: Haake, Kenkel and Parkhurst NAYES: None
