The Board of Supervisors of Shelby County, Iowa, met pursuant to law and rules of said board in special session at 8:00 a.m. in the Supervisors Board room in the Shelby County Courthouse. The following Elected officials were present Darin Haake, Chairman; Steve Kenkel, Vice-Chairperson; Supervisor Charles Parkhurst came in at 9:04 and Mark Maxwell, Clerk.

The meeting was called to order, and it was asked by the Chairperson about any conflicts of interest, none were stated.
