

The Shelby County Board of Supervisors met in a regular session at 9:00 A.M. in the Supervisors Chamber in the Courthouse with the following members present: Steve Kenkel, Charles Parkhurst, Bryce Schaben, and Mark Maxwell, Clerk.

The Chairperson, Steve Kenkel, asked that any conflict of interest be stated concerning any item on the agenda. None were stated.

It was moved by Parkhurst, seconded by Schaben, to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously.

It was moved by Schaben, seconded by Parkhurst to approve the minutes of February 21st, 2023. Motion carried unanimously.

It was moved by Parkhurst, seconded by Schaben, to designate the Auditor’s Office to compile the results of the IKM-Manning Special Election and the Exira-Elkhorn Kimbalton special election held on March 7th, Carroll and Crawford Counties will hold their own Canvasses for the IKM-Manning election and report back to Shelby County. Shelby County will Canvass the Shelby County results for the Exira-Elkhorn-Kimbalton and report the results to Audubon County for the final Canvass performed by Audubon County. The Supervisors will hold the final Canvass next week for the IKM Manning election, combining the canvassed totals of Shelby, Audubon, Crawford and Carroll counties. Maxwell explained that tabulation from Audubon County is comingled with the results from Shelby County as Shelby County was designated to hold the election for Audubon County. This procedure was allowed because in this instance Audubon County has less than 125 voters in the IKM-Manning school district. This allows them to have the control County hold the election for them. Next week the final canvass for this election will be held Tuesday March 21st.
