The Shelby County Board of Supervisors met in a special session at 9:00 A.M. in the Supervisors Chamber in the Courthouse with the following members present: Steve Kenkel, Charles Parkhurst, Bryce Schaben, and Mark Maxwell, Clerk.

The Chairperson, Steve Kenkel, asked that any conflict of interest be stated concerning any item on the agenda. None were stated.

It was moved by Schaben , seconded by Parkhurst, to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously.

It was moved by Parkhurst, seconded by Schaben to approve the minutes of June 4th, 2024. Motion carried unanimously.

The current annual Southwest Iowa Planning Council agreement was then considered for authorization for the Chairperson to sign. Schaben made a motion to approve the signature, Parkhurst seconded the motion. The motion was approved unanimously.

The sale of the Annex building owned by Shelby County was then discussed. Parkhurst made a motion to place a deadline of July 15th, at 4:30, for submittal of any bids and the minimum bid of \$200,000.00 being used as a starting bid point for bidders. Each bid shall include a 10% down payment for acceptance of their bid. Copies of the proposed contract and current leases are available at the Auditors office. Schaben seconded the motion, the motion passed unanimously.

This being the day designated for the 2024 Primary Election Canvass the Supervisors then had the results of the nominations for the November ballot for Partisan races which will include the winners of the Primary contests.
