appoint a Deputy Auditor

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 331.903(1), Code of Iowa, Mark L. Maxwell, Shelby County Auditor, has submitted to the Board of Supervisors, Shelby County, Iowa, for approval of Taryn Knapp, for appointment as Deputy Shelby County Auditor through December 31, 2024, at which time Auditor Maxwell's term will end, and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors, Shelby County, Iowa, finds Taryn Knapp to be qualified to serve as Deputy Shelby County Auditor, and

**WHEREAS**, Taryn Knapp is now Auditor Elect in Shelby County, Iowa. The results of the General election being duly canvassed, and

**WHEREAS**, Iowa has limited training for County Elected officials and the duties that accompany the Auditors office and transition to becoming Shelby County Auditor by Taryn Knapp may be eased with the experiences as Deputy Auditor before December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2024.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** by the Board of Supervisors, Shelby County, Iowa, that the appointment of Taryn Knapp as Deputy Shelby County Auditor by Mark L. Maxwell, Shelby County Auditor, through December 31, 2024, at which time Auditor Maxwell's term will end, is hereby approved.

Dated at Harlan, Shelby County, Iowa, this 12th day of November, 2024. Kenkel, Parkhurst and Schaben all voted in favor of the resolution, no nays were cast.
