

The Shelby County Board of Supervisors met in regular session at 9:00 A.M. in the Supervisors Chamber in the Courthouse with the following members present: Charles Parkhurst, Mike Kolbe, Bryce Schaben, and Taryn Knapp, Clerk.

Chairman, Charles Parkhurst, asked that any conflict of interest be stated concerning any item on the agenda. None was stated

It was moved by Kolbe, seconded by Schaben, to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously.

It was moved by Schaben, seconded by Kolbe to approve the minutes of February 17th, 2026. Motion carried unanimously.

It was moved by Kolbe, seconded by Schaben to approve the recently processed claims. Motion carried unanimously.

Library Directors, Paulette Madson, Elk Horn, Tara Painter, Harlan, and LaJissa Niklasen, Irwin, thanked the Supervisors for their continued support and provided breakdowns of how they utilize the funds from Shelby County.
