The Shelby County Board of Supervisors met in regular session at 9:00 A.M. in the Supervisors Chamber in the Courthouse with the following members present: Charles Parkhurst, Mike Kolbe, Bryce Schaben, and Taryn Knapp, Clerk.

Chairman, Charles Parkhurst, asked that any conflict of interest be stated concerning any item on the agenda. None was stated

It was moved by Kolbe, seconded by Schaben, to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously.

It was moved by Kolbe, seconded by Schaben to approve the minutes of March 31st, 2026. Motion carried unanimously.

Schaben made a motion to approve the recently processed claims; Kolbe seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Engineer, Chris Fredericksen, presented a ROW permit for approval. Schaben made a motion to approve the ROW permit for Nishnabotna Valley REC; Kolbe seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Fredericksen then asked the Supervisors to consider changes to the hourly rate for secondary roads seasonal employees. After discussion, Kolbe made a motion to approve adding COLA to the hourly rate in year 4 of return employment and every year thereafter, Schaben seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

The Engineer then gave a department update which included thanking the public for their patience while Spring maintenance is being completed on the roadways. Secondary Roads will be starting their Summer hours of four 10-hour days, Monday through Thursday. There will be office staff in the office on Fridays.

Schaben made a motion to approve the Kirkham Michael NSTM Bridge Inspection Engineering Services Agreement; Kolbe seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

There were no department heads present to give a report.

Supervisors gave a brief update on meetings they attended.

Having no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 9:12 A.M.
