The Shelby County Board of Supervisors met in regular session at 9:00 A.M. in the Supervisors Chamber in the Courthouse with the following members present: Charles Parkhurst, Mike Kolbe, Bryce Schaben, and Taryn Knapp, Clerk.

Chairman, Charles Parkhurst, asked that any conflict of interest be stated concerning any item on the agenda. None was stated

It was moved by Schaben, seconded by Kolbe, to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously.

It was moved by Kolbe, seconded by Schaben to approve the minutes of May 19th, 2026. Motion carried unanimously.

Schaben made a motion to approve the recently processed claims; Kolbe seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Miranda Wachter and Amber Godwin gave an update on Behavioral Health changes and services available to Shelby County residents. It has been almost 1 year since the 11 regions became 7 districts.

Engineer Chris Fredericksen then asked the Supervisors to consider an increase in the non-union step wages. Schaben made a motion to approve a \$0.50 increase for the employees on non-union step wages, which includes foremen and assistance engineer, after the July 1, 2026 COLA; Kolbe seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Fredericksen stated a newly signed legislation raises the current speed limit on most two-lane highways and rural roads from 55 mph to 60 mph. It takes effect July 1st. Secondary Roads will place overlay stickers on the current signs and work to replace all signs overtime.

Schaben made a motion to approve the renewal of the Employment Contract and Agreement for County Engineer; Kolbe seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

No department head reports were given. Supervisors gave updates on meetings they attended.

Kolbe made a motion to appoint Gervas Mgonja and Tony Carter, and re-appoint Betty Larsen, Vicki Errett, and Darin Haake as members of the Shelby County Board of Adjustment, Schaben seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Schaben made a motion to appoint Steve Kenkel and re-appoint Roger Kenkel, Kirk Petersen, Keith Burchett, Stacey Ferry, and Shawn Carter as members of the Shelby County Planning and Zoning Board, Kolbe seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Schaben made a motion to approve the Class "C" Retail Alcohol License Renewal for Lonely Oak Distillery, LLC, Kolbe seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Kolbe made a motion to approve the Special Class "C" Retail Alcohol License for SingleSpeed Brewing Co., Schaben seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Planning and Zoning Administrator Tony Buman gave an update on the Master Matrix Scoring and Recommendation for Gerald and Nancy Croghan Farm. There were no verbal or written comments submitted.

There was no discussion on potential handbook changes.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:27 A.M.
