The Shelby County Board of Supervisors met in regular session at 9:00 A.M. in the Supervisors Chamber in the Courthouse with the following members present: Charles Parkhurst, Mike Kolbe, Bryce Schaben, and Taryn Knapp, Clerk.

Chairman, Charles Parkhurst, asked that any conflict of interest be stated concerning any item on the agenda. None was stated

It was moved by Kolbe, seconded by Schaben, to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously.

It was moved by Schaben, seconded by Kolbe to approve the minutes of July 21st, 2026. Motion carried unanimously.

Schaben made a motion to approve the recently processed claims; Kolbe seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Kolbe made a motion to approve a ROW permit for Nishnabotna Valley REC at the intersection of 1500th and M47, Schaben seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Engineer Chris Fredericksen, then presented a Federal Aid Agreement for consideration. Schaben made a motion and Kolbe seconded the motion to approve the Iowa DOT Federal Aid Agreement for Competitive Highway Bridge Project : BRS-CHBP-CO83(91)--GB-83 DOT Agreement No.: 4-26-CHBP-015. Motion carried unanimously.

Luke Wolken, Environmental Health Director presented Shelby County Private Water Well Permitting Policy and Procedures document for approval. Kolbe made a motion and Schaben seconded the motion to approve. Motion carried unanimously.

Kolbe made a motion and Schaben seconded the motion to approve the Treasurer's Office Semi-Annual report. Motion carried unanimously.

Treasurer, Carolyn Blum, then gave a department update on new pocket talk translators provided by the Iowa Department of Transportation. These translators have become very popular across all counties.

Kyle Lindberg, Jail Administrator, gave a department report stating there have been 301 bookings to date with a daily average inmate population of 11.

Supervisors reported on meetings they attended.
